DALRC Retiree Assistance Program, Inc.

DALRC Retiree Assistance Program, Inc. (RAP): RAP is a 501(c)(3) charitable organization whose mission is to offer financial assistance with health insurance premiums to Delta's domestic retirees, spouses, and their qualified survivors who are facing challenging financial situations because of health-related issues. This non-profit organization is administered by volunteers who are Delta retirees and is funded by donations from active employees and retirees.

DALRC, Inc.: DALRC, Inc., dba Delta Retirees Connection (DRC), is a non-profit 501(c)(5) organization with a focus on issues of common interest to support future and current Delta retirees. It also focuses on legislative issues affecting retirees and provides a service called the ABC's of Retirement; a program of resources to help members navigate into and through retirement. The Legislative Program monitors such issues as Social Security, Medicare, prescription drug costs, etc. DRC offers a program called the Old Friends Locator for members to find and be reacquainted with old friends from Delta. An annual tour program is also available to all members in good standing. Membership is open to all Delta retirees, spouses, survivors and active employees.

Delta Clipped Wings, Inc. (DCW): DCW is a 501(c)(3) organization based in Atlanta, GA and has been charity based since its inception in 1957. Membership is open to all retired and active Delta flight attendants. Social events are scheduled from September through May with an annual March fundraiser in support of three recognized charities. Delta Golden Wings, Inc. (DGW): DGW is a fraternal organization of retired and active Delta pilots (and spouses). Annual social events include: a May Fly-in/Drive-in at the Alexander Memorial Airport in Williamson, Georgia; a Fall Reunion and Membership Meeting in a different city each year which features city tours, banquets and special events; and an annual Christmas party held in Dunwoody, Georgia. Periodic gatherings are arranged locally in different cities. These activities bring pilots together to meet with old friends and make new ones. DGW sponsors a \$1500 annual scholarship for flight training to a deserving candidate in the Candler Field Youth Aviation Program.
